1 OPENING

1.1 WELCOME AND PRACTICAL INFORMATION

2.1 ISIRA ACTIVITY REPORTS

2.1.1 IASC SUB-OFFICE AT THE ARKHANGELSK SCIENTIFIC CENTER

IASC Vice President Vladimir Pavlenko, Director of the Arkhangelsk Scientific Center of the Ural Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences, introduced the new Russian sub-office of the IASC Secretariat hosted by the Arkhangelsk Science Center.

2.1.2 Russian Arctic Activities

Some core science initiatives and activities in the Russian Arctic were presented by Sergey Priamikov, Arctic and Antarctic Research Institute.

Sergey Kirpotin introduced ISIRA-relevant Arctic research activities of Tomsk State University.



2.1.3 RUSSIAN EARLY CAREER SCIENTISTS

Russian early career scientists Kirill Kivva and Tatiana Matveeva were introduced and invited to make their research presentations. PDF versions of the presentations are available on the ISIRA website.

2.1.4 ISIRA WEBSITE AND NEWSLETTER

IASC Fellows Andrian Vlakhov and Yulia Zaika introduced the new Russian version of the ISIRA website and a Russian edition of the IASC Newsletter.

2.2 NATIONAL REPORTS

Brief national summaries were given by the ISIRA Members. Complete inventories were provided by each ISIRA member country in written form before the meeting, using the ISIRA national reporting template. Under this agenda item members of ISIRA from US, Germany and Japan highlighted several major bi-lateral and international projects in the Russian Arctic.
