IASC Connects Arctic Scientists

- ...to the international Arctic research community by convening the annual Arctic Science Summit Week
- ...to each other across disciplines (physical/ natural/social sciences) and 23 countries through scientific Working Groups
- ...to the Arctic policy community by contributing to the work of the Arctic Council as an Observer
- IASC **promotes inclusion** and more balanced participation in the Arctic science community.

IASC Facilitates Arctic Research

- IASC Working Groups provide funds annually for science facilitation and coordination.
- Working Group funds are available to support relevant projects via an open application process.
- Up to 15.000€ for sponsoring small, targeted meetings, workshops, and other projects

IASC Supports Early Career Researchers

- More than 40% of IASC scientific funds support early career researchers.
- Annual Fellowship Program sponsors ECR to learn from and contribute to international Arctic science coordination
- Partner with APECS & UArctic to provide more opportunities for ECR
